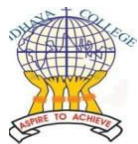
#### **HISTORY AND OBJECTIVES OF OUR INSTITUTION:**

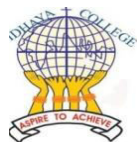

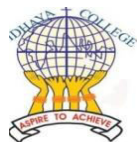
