



1.5 TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS

Following the **Choice Based Credit System** of Alagappa University, tests are conducted regularly. Students' progress and Evaluation Report for each student are informed through postal and SMS immediately for the perusal of the parents and the feedback is collected from them. If the student doesn't show any improvement, parents are called to meet the principal and class in charge. Remedial classes are also conducted for the slow learners.

1.6 REMEDIAL COACHING

Based on their performance in the first internal test, the slow learners of the subject are identified by the course teacher concerned. To create a healthy and conducive environment for slow learners mainly for first generation learners and Tamil medium students, Remedial Coaching classes are conducted regularly. Thus their academic needs are assessed and they are provided an appropriate learning environment with the support of peer learning to the vernacular medium students. The outcome of such remedial coaching supports the students to cope with their studies and join the mainstream.

Day 3- 29.12.2023




Day 4 - 30.12.2023

4.1 SPOKEN ENGLISH

The main motto of conducting this Spoken English class is to enrich Tamil medium students with English language. Then only they can speak English confidentiality.

The objectives of conducting the Spoken English class is

- Involve students in practical activity oriented class rather than traditional study method
- Prepare for personal interviews and group discussions
- To help students identify their flaws in English pronunciation and have an individual plan to rectify them.

To help students understand the influences on correct English pronunciation.

The spoken English classes for the year 2023 was organized by the department of English from **18.07.2023 to 25.07.2023** For all the first year students. Nearly **161 students** participated. They

had five classes per day for learning basic English. To make language more interesting, The students were taught **LSRW skills, grammar, etc**.

In the first session **Ms.A.Josephine Parakasi** taught active skills. each and every student was given a chance to do the activity. They enjoyed well and at the same time they learnt the active skills.

In the afternoon session **Ms.T.Anitha** taught Passive skills. the students were given reading practice. the audio was played understood events answered well after hearing the audio.

The next day Mrs. C Priya taught introducing ourselves and others, road map, Idioms and phrases using in day-to-day life. The students were given chance to come front and say the tongue twisters. To create interest, the English songs were played. The best students were given chocolates.

In the afternoon session, Mrs. SP.Visalakshi, HOD of English gave an introduction about the importance of English Language and the uses of English Language. She motivated the students to read the new paper every day and insisted them to learn at least five new words every day to improve the language skill. She taught grammar active voice and passive voice. She explained the rules and regulations and gave plentiful of examples the students enjoyed a lot and did the exercise. The game "Guess what" was conducted. The students were enthusiastically participated and the students who told first was given a pen as a gift.

The next day **Ms.B.Manjula** taught Parts of speech, Tenses and Verb through PPT. The exercises were given to the students and the students who scored good marks were rewarded with the pouch.




