6. Admission Requirements

A student seeking admission must have completed Higher Secondary Education. The following certificates should be produced at the time of admission:

- ❖ Original Transfer and Conduct Certificate.
- ❖ Original Tamilnadu Higher Secondary Certificate (or its equivalent Certificate in original).
- ❖ Candidates who have passed examination other than Tamilnadu Higher Secondary, should produce Eligibility Certificate from Alagappa University, Karaikudi.
- ❖ Ten Recent Passport Size photographs (2.5'x2')
- ❖ Original Community Certificate and two photo copies (Xerox) attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- ❖ Eligible candidates for SC/ST Scholarship should provide: Income Certificate, Community Certificate, Family Card, Passbook (Student's Name Account), Marksheet.

A sufficient knowledge of English (to be able to follow the lectures) is an indispensable condition for admission.

7. Semester Fees

Semester Fees shall be paid without fine within **30 working days**. Those who pay after that has to pay a fine of Rs.100.

8. Bus Fees

- ❖ Students are reminded to maintain discipline and decorum while travelling in the College bus.
- ❖ College bus pass will be issued at the beginning of the academic year. Students are expected to pay the bus fee for the each semester **within 15 working days** of the College from the date of reopening.
- ❖ They should produce the bus pass to the Leader of the bus every time while getting into the bus.
- ❖ **The bus pass is not transferable.**

Note

- 1. College fees and bus fees should be paid on or before the prescribed dates. Late fee will be collected with fine.**

2. Once the college fee or bus fee is paid, it will not be returned.

9. Library

The library is open to all the members of the college on every working day from **8.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.** Students should visit the library frequently and do intelligent reading and reference work without negligence.

1. **Strict silence** should be observed inside the library.
2. No member shall take any printed book or notebook into the library.
3. Books must not be marked or defaced. The pages should not be earmarked. Students should examine each book before borrowing it and report to the librarian if any damage is found therein. If they fail to do so they will be held responsible for any damage detected while returning the book.
4. Periodicals placed on the magazine racks should not be mishandled ; They should be replaced on the racks after use.
5. Reference books and periodicals will not be issued but are available for reference within the library.
6. Staff and students shall be held responsible if any book or library property is damaged by them.
7. Overdue charges shall be imposed on each day a book is overdue. Absence from the college shall not be admitted as an excuse for delay in returning a book.
8. Date labels shall not be tampered with.
9. The Librarian may get back any book at any time even before the expiry of the normal period of lending.
10. No staff or student is allowed to lend books to anyone in or outside the college on their own.
11. Library books will not be lent either to students or to staff during the vacation.
12. Books, when in use, must always be covered. They should not be left out in any place within the campus or outside.

13. For the Departmental libraries, the rules of the main library is also applicable. Staff-in-charge of departmental library will have to replace the books if they lost the books.

10. Conclusion

To foster faith in Christianity, religious classes are conducted for the catholic students. To inculcate moral values, value education classes are conducted for the non-catholic students. Both classes are obligatory.

Gathering bookish knowledge does not make the collegiate education complete. Students must be taught the importance of service to the society. Our college can boast of plethora of clubs and NSS. Enrolling themselves in any one of these service oriented clubs is must for students.

RULES AND CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Each Idhayamite is looked upon, as an individual endowed by God with certain talents, characters and personalities which must be developed and harvested. Idhaya looks to each of her students to uphold the standard of the college, within the campus, and outside throughout her life.

1. This college is devoted for learning. Students should imbibe the sound traditions of cultured life offered by the college.
2. Identity card for all the students will be issued soon after their admission into the college. Every student has to wear the identity card every day. It is absolutely essential during the examination days for obtaining Scholarship, Certificates, Library entry etc.
3. Students should conduct themselves in such a way as not to bring discredit to the college or to themselves.
4. Students and faculty members should avoid doing anything by word and deed which may disturb the unity and harmony of life both in the college and hostel. They can individually approach the Management to express their needs.
5. The authorities of the management are directly incharge of the integral formation of the students. They should make use of this opportunity to get all the guidance needed.
6. Since the Students opt for English as the medium of instruction, they should **speak in ENGLISH inside the college and hostel.**
7. Students should maintain **cleanliness and safeguard the properties** of the Institution.

DRESS CODE:

Staff and Students are expected to be neatly dressed in accordance with the rules of approved etiquette, decency and modesty. **Every Monday**, and on **Celebration days** and **University exam days** students are expected to come in uniform.

CODE OF PROFESSIONAL ETHICS FOR TEACHERS

I. TEACHERS AND THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES:

Whoever adopts teaching as a profession assumes the obligation to conduct her in accordance with the ideal of the profession. A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of her students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should see that there should be uniformity between her precepts and practice. The national ideals of education which have already been set forth and which she should seek to inculcate among students must be her own ideals. The profession further requires that the teachers should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and cordial in nature.

Teachers should:

- (i) Adhere to a responsible pattern of conduct and behavior expected of them by the College;
- (ii) Manage their private affairs in a manner consistent with the dignity and decorum of the profession;
- (iii) Seek to make professional growth continuous through study and research;
- (iv) Express free and frank opinion by participation at professional meetings, seminars, conferences etc. towards the contribution of knowledge;
- (v) Maintain active membership of professional organizations and strive to improve education and profession through them;
- (vi) Perform their duties in the form of teaching, tutorial, practical, seminar and research work carefully with dedication;

(vii) Co-operate and assist in carrying out functions relating to the educational responsibilities of the college and the university such as: assisting in appraising applications for admission, advising and counseling students as well as assisting the conduct of University and College examinations, including supervision, invigilation and evaluation; and

(viii) Participate in extension, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities including community service.

II. TEACHERS AND STUDENTS

(i) Respect the right and dignity of the student in expressing her opinion;

(ii) Deal justly and impartially with students regardless of their religion, caste, political, economic, social and physical characteristics;

(iii) Recognize the difference in aptitude and capabilities among students and strive to meet their individual needs;

(iv) Encourage students to improve their attainments, develop their personalities and at the same time contribute to community welfare;

(v) Inculcate among students scientific outlook and respect for physical labour and ideals of democracy, patriotism and peace;

(vi) Be affectionate to the students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason;

(vii) Pay attention to only the attainment of the student in the assessment of merit;

(viii) Make themselves available to the students even beyond their class hours and help and guide students without any remuneration or reward;

(ix) Aid students to develop an understanding of our national heritage and national goals; and

(x) Refrain from inciting students against other students, colleagues or administration.

III. TEACHERS AND COLLEAGUES

- (i) Treat other members of the profession in the same manner as they themselves wish to be treated;
- (ii) Speak respectfully of other teachers and render assistance for professional betterment;
- (iii) Refrain from lodging unconfirmed allegations against colleagues to higher authorities; and allowing considerations of caste, creed, religion, race or sex in their professional endeavour.

IV. TEACHERS AND AUTHORITIES:

- (i) Discharge their professional responsibilities according to the existing rules and regulations;
- (ii) Refrain from undertaking any other employment and commitment including private tuitions and coaching classes which are likely to interfere with their professional responsibilities;
- (iii) Co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution by accepting various offices and discharge responsibilities which such offices may demand;
- (iv) Co-operate with the authorities for the betterment of the institutions keeping in view the interest and in accordance with dignity of the profession;
- (v) Should adhere to the conditions of contract;
- (vi) Give and expect due notice before a change of position is made; and
- (vii) Refrain from availing themselves of leave except on unavoidable grounds and as far as practicable with prior intimation,

V. TEACHERS AND NON-TEACHING STAFF:

Teachers should treat the non-teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners in a cooperative manner.

VI. TEACHERS AND PARENTS/ GUARDIANS

- (i) Try to maintain contact with the parents/guardians.
- (ii) Send reports of students' performance to the parents /guardians whenever necessary and
- (iii) Meet them in meetings convened for the purpose of mutual exchange of ideas and for the benefit of the institution.

VII. TEACHERS AND SOCIETY

- (i) Recognize that education is a public service and strive to keep the public informed of the educational program which are being provided;
- (ii) Work to improve education in the community and strengthen the community's moral and intellectual life;
- (iii) Be aware of social problems and take part in such activities as would be conducive to the progress of society and hence the country as a whole;
- (iv) Perform the duties of citizenship, participate in community activities and shoulder responsibilities of public offices;
- (v) Refrain from taking part in or subscribing to or assisting in any way activities, which tend to promote feeling of hatred or enmity among different communities, religions or linguistic groups but actively work for National Integration.

ATTENDANCE

1. Alagappa University, Karaikudi has prescribed the following UGC regulations with regard to the number of working days and attendance. Each affiliated college shall work during an academic year for a **minimum period of 180 days or 900 instructional hours.**
2. The working day is divided into two sessions with four periods in the morning, and two periods in the afternoon.

3. A Student entering the college late for the Morning Prayer will not be admitted into class, unless she produces the Academic Calendar with the late entry signed by the principal or the HOD.
4. Attendance shall be taken at the beginning of every session. The student who is not in the class when attendance is taken will be marked as absent.
5. The Student requiring leave from a class or a portion of a class must apply for it in person to the lecturer incharge of the class. If she wishes to leave the college during class hours, she should see the Principal and get her consent. If she is a hosteller she should get the consent of the hostel incharge sister too.
6. **No leave will be granted during internal exams and University exams** unless for reasons of grave necessity which must be proved to the satisfaction of the Principal. In case of illness, a medical certificate from a doctor recognized by the government should be produced.
7. Staff and students must be present on the reopening day after vacation and on the last working day of every semester.
8. No student shall be absent herself without prior permission. Application for leave shall be made well in advance to the Principal in the leave form. **When absence is due to unforeseen circumstances, application for leave should be submitted on the first day of return.** Leave will not be granted during college working hours for the purpose of meeting parents, relatives and friends.
9. The annual certificate of Attendance and Progress required by the university to permit the students to sit in the university examination will be given only if:
 - a. The Principal is satisfied with the progress and conduct of the student.
 - b. The student has attended at least **three fourth** of the number of working days prescribed by the college.
 - c. The student has satisfactorily undergone the prescribed course in physical training.

PHYSICAL TRAINING

A sound body is the place for a sound mind. Every student is required to undergo the course of physical training prescribed by the college. The course of physical training includes field, sports, games and exercises. Facilities are available for practicing athletic events in the vast, wide and extensive play field situated within the Campus.

2. State and university players are identified, given privilege in tuition fees and also provided free of Hostel accommodation.
3. Intramural games and sports are conducted and **talented players will be encouraged** to participate in the Inter - Collegiate and Inter - University sports and games which bring laurels to the College.
4. Certificate of attendance will be given to such candidates who represent the College at such Inter - University and Inter - Collegiate games, subject to the condition that their periodical test, exams and general academic progress are not affected.

CERTIFICATES

1. The student former or present, desiring to obtain a certificate (Transfer, age, conduct, bonafide, course completion, etc...,) shall apply for it, by making a formal written request to the principal.
2. The application should be submitted along with a search fee of Rs.10/-.

3. A Certificate will not generally be issued less than 48 hours of notice.

COLLEGE UNION

The office bearers or the college union are **the President, Vice-President, Secretaries and Ministers, Class representatives, Club secretaries and secretaries of each discipline.** The College union members are selected among the nominated candidates by **1. Principal, 2. Vice Principal, 3. HODs, 4. Staff Secretary & Treasurer, 5. Class Representatives and 6. Secretaries of Various Clubs.** The class representatives are elected by their respective classes at the beginning of the academic year. The secretaries of the various clubs are also elected by the members of their own clubs.

LOUIS DUPUIS HOSTEL

1. **LOUIS DUPUIS Hostel** is under the direct control of the college authorities who will act as “Loco parents” to all the inmates.
2. Only those who are medically fit will be admitted.
3. Students found guilty of insubordination, theft or insincerity will be summarily dismissed especially when a timely warning has proved ineffective. Similarly Students forming themselves into cliques dangerous to good discipline will be expelled immediately.
4. Hostellers will not ordinarily leave the hostel on weekend holidays. They are admitted into the hostel on the understanding that they will study hard and as such should utilize the weekend holidays for this purpose. But they are freely permitted to go home on terminal holidays.
5. Parents or guardians may visit the students once in a month that is on the **fourth Sunday**.
6. No students are allowed to see the parents during college hours without the permission of the Principal.
7. Students living in the hostel shall be under the disciplinary supervision of the sister incharge of resident students and her assistant may freely approach them for any help.

Please Note:

1. **Ragging is a serious offence** entailing immediate dismissal from the college. Any kind of wild, noisy and disturbing celebrations are strictly forbidden inside the college.
2. Students found using drugs or alcohol and those found peddling drugs will be dismissed from the college immediately.
3. No student is allowed to take tuition from the lecturers of the college.

4. Every student is expected to enroll herself in the National Service Scheme or in any other voluntary groups in the college committed as community service.
5. With the permission of the Principal and the Hostel in-charge, students are allowed to use the mobile inside the college and in the hostel for academic purpose only.
