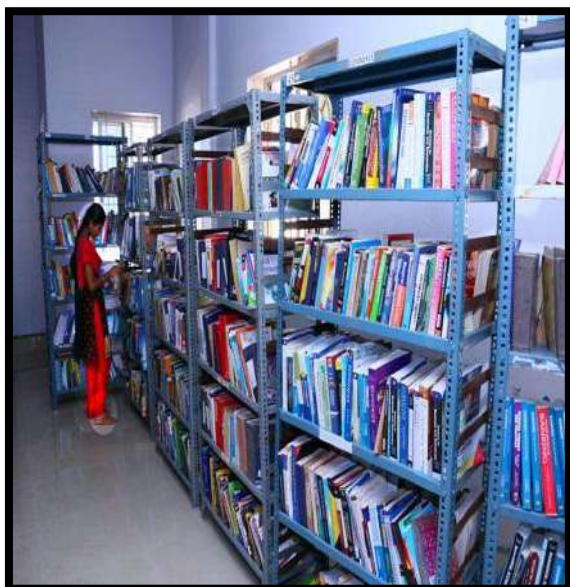

### **1.5 TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS**

Following the **Choice Based Credit System** of Alagappa University, tests are conducted regularly. Students' progress and Evaluation Report for each student are informed through postal and SMS immediately for the perusal of the parents and the feedback is collected from them. If the student doesn't show any improvement, parents are called to meet the Principal and class incharge. Remedial classes are also conducted for the slow learners.

### **1.6 REMEDIAL COACHING**

Based on their performance in the first internal test, the slow learners of the subject are identified by the course teacher concerned. To create a healthy and conducive environment for slow learners mainly for first generation learners and Tamil medium students, Remedial Coaching classes are conducted regularly. Thus their academic needs are assessed and they are provided an appropriate learning environment with the support of peer learning to the vernacular medium students. The outcome of such remedial coaching supports the students to cope with their studies and join the mainstream.

**"The essence of an MOU lies in the promise of cooperation, collaboration, and the pursuit of excellence."**

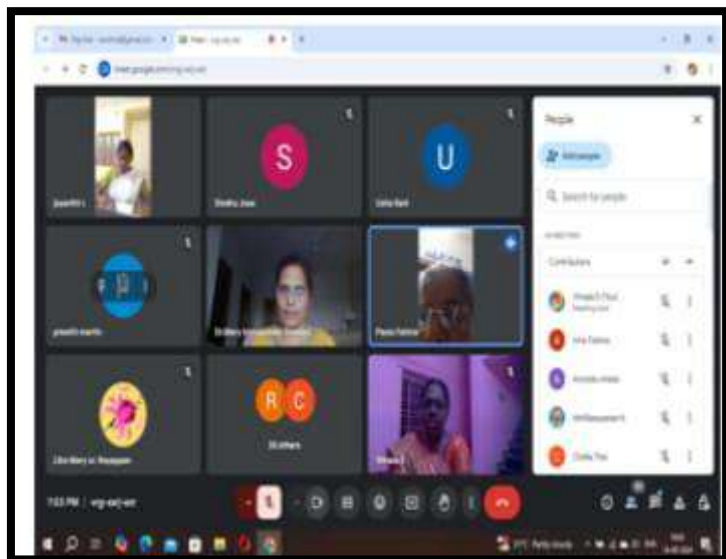

- Discussed the implications of AI for enhancing research efficiency and outcomes.

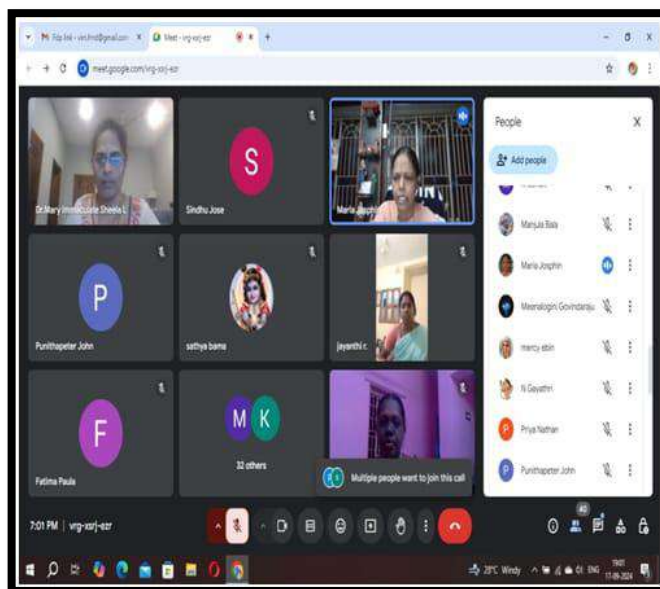
## Practical Session
