CODE OF PROFESSIONAL ETHICS FOR TEACHERS

LTEACHERS AND THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES:

Whoever adopts teaching as a profession assumes the obligation to conduct her in accordance with the ideal of the profession. A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of her students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should see that there should be uniformity between her precepts and practice. The national ideals of education which have already been set forth and which she should seek to inculcate among students must be her own ideals. The profession further requires that the teachers should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and cordial in nature.

Teachers should:

- (i) Adhere to a responsible pattern of conduct and behavior expected of them by the College:
- (ii) Manage their private affairs in a manner consistent with the dignity and decorum of the profession;
- (iii) Seek to make professional growth continuous through study and research;
- (iv)Express free and frank opinion by participation at professional meetings, seminars, conferences etc. towards the contribution of knowledge;
- (v) Maintain active membership of professional organizations and strive to improve education and profession through them;
- (vi)Perform their duties in the form of teaching, tutorial, practical, seminar and research work carefully with dedication;
- (vii) Co-operate and assist in carrying out functions relating to the educational responsibilities of the college and the university such as: assisting in appraising applications for admission, advising and counseling students as well as assisting the conduct of University and College examinations, including supervision, invigilation and evaluation; and
- (viii) Participate in extension, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities including community service.

II.TEACHERS AND STUDENTS

- Respect the right and dignity of the student in expressing her opinion;
- (ii) Deal justly and impartially with students regardless of their religion, caste, political, economic, social and physical characteristics;

- (ii) Speak respectfully of other teachers and render assistance for professional
- (iii) Refrain from lodging unconfirmed allegations against colleagues to higher authorities; and allowing considerations of caste, creed, religion, race or sex in their professional endeavour.
